

Who is CODI?

The Co-ordinating Organisation for the Disabled in Ipswich Inc, (affectionately known as CODI) is a non-profit making organisation providing transport for the frail, aged and people with disabilities in the Ipswich and West Moreton Regions.

CODI was formed in 1981 during 'The Year of the Disabled' from support of the Ipswich City Rotary Club. In the early years CODI was able to provide assistance (either financial or some material) for people who are frail, aged or disabled and are disadvantaged by their disabilities. However in recent years providing a transport service has become our main objective.

CODI's primary role is to provide a community transport for the frail, aged and people with disabilities to and from Day Respite, Doctors, OPD, Day Surgery, Dialysis, QRI, Allied Health, Nursing Homes and Hostels or other designated venues (by bookings only) with the nominal fare applicable.

Eligibility for non-urgent medical transport

(must meet at least one of the criteria)

- ◆ Be frail, aged person
- ◆ Have a disability
- ◆ Be a carer
- ◆ Be living at home
- ◆ Be a resident of Ipswich, West Moreton or Western Suburbs of Brisbane
- ◆ Be transport disadvantaged
- ◆ To be eligible for HACC (Home And Community Care) services, the client must reside in Ipswich & West Moreton area only*.

Service guidelines

- Client contributions are for return trip where both legs of the trip occur on the same day.
- Servicing specific areas, ring office for further details.
- A registered carer is welcome to accompany a client for a contribution of \$5 and subject to availability of seats.
- Any parking and tollway fees will be at the client's expense
- Prices vary for a return trip to either Brisbane or Ipswich hospitals - phone the CODI office for a current price.

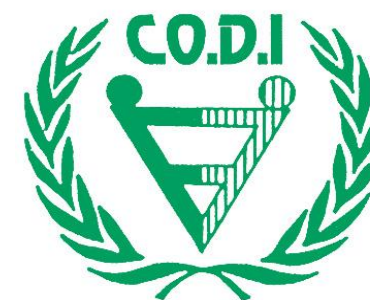
